In his opening comments, Steve thanked Odis and Mary Pippins for hosting us and setting up a great lunch downtown.

With no changes needed to **previous meeting minutes**, they were accepted as published by voice vote, none opposed.

Treasurers Report: Ruth Fredericksen was with us and went through her Treasurers Report. As usual this time of year, income was from membership renewals and sale of Pate Swap Meet spaces with no unusual expenses. At the end of the meeting there were only 3 spaces left for purchase. Ruth also informed us that 9 members were not renewing which puts us at 93 members for now. Ruth also asked about help with Treasurers duties while she's on her "summer break" and Denis Springer stepped up and said he'd help out. With unanimous approval by voice vote, none opposed, Treasurers Report accepted as presented, copy on file.

Sunshine Report: With Brenda Lambert absent, Steve Springer noted how nice it was to have Denis Springer back with us. He said Lonnie Henderson was "up and about". When he asked about anniversaries for the month, we found out Steve and Pat Koehn are celebrating 50 years of marriage and Robert and Mildred Deets are celebrating 60 years.

Pate Report: Steve Koehn summed up the last Pate Directors Meeting as follows:

- Vendors will be escorted from 8-12 with a hard main gate close at 10am.
- New or same day registrants will be escorted.
- After 12, Pate volunteers who are not busy will be part of a "labor pool" to help out where they might be needed.
- Trash pick-up contract has been cancelled and saves approx. \$4000. One of the larger clubs will be handling that duty.
- The large motorcycle group will return this year, but will not be back.
- There will be a large tent available to certain dealers/vendors.
